Northwest District Firefighters and Lemmon Fire Department are hosting a Firefighter Survival and Basic Air Management class on March 8, 2014 at 8:00AM. The location will be held at the Lemmon Fire Station. This training is free of charge to all firefighters.

Fire Departments in the rural Dakotas in most cases do not have enough personal on their roster to support a true RIT team. That is why we need to have the training and education to help small departments handle these situations. The class offered will show tactics on how to respond to a mayday call or other reasons one would need rapid intervention.

This class will cover basic air management with SCBA's and hands on training on how we can self-rescue ourselves from a mayday and inform others on tactics they can use to rescue a trapped or downed firefighter.

Full PPE and current SCBA are required for the hands on portion of the class.
