COURSE LISTING

1. Live Fire Training – Live Fire Attack and Technique Training – 6 hrs.

Training will consist of a short AM classroom session covering basic principles of Safety, SCBA and Fire Streams. The remainder of the AM and all afternoon will be spent doing hands on training with Live Fire. Participants will put their knowledge and skills to use in the two-story Mobile Live Fire Training Unit. These hands on training will simulate conditions encountered in actual interior structure fires (live fire, heat, humidity and smoke). Any students needing to fulfill the ‘Live Fire Training’ portion of their SD FF Certification Blue Card should bring it to class. If all pre-requisites are met the applicable hands on tasks on the blue card can be completed and signed.

Equipment Requirements: Students must have full Structural PPE (including hood) and SCBA in **GOOD & SERVICEABLE condition** that was NFPA compliant at manufacture date. If possible a spare SCBA cylinder should be brought as well.

2. Auto Extrication - 6 hrs.

The complete extrication scene, from initial contact, stabilization, extrication, and some patient packaging and patient delivery to EMS. Participants must furnish approved helmet, fire boots or leather safety boots, eye protection, gloves, coveralls or turnout gear for class

3. Grain Extrication – 6 hrs.

The class will focus on safely entering a grain bin, and safely getting the equipment needed for the rescue or recovery inside the bin without injury or risk to the rescue personnel. We will explore the option of using an aerial device safely and point out all the sharp edges found on grain bins that can harm safety ropes and first responders during a bin rescue or recovery. 4. Electrical Safety - 3 hrs. (Morning)

This class will provide information on properties and safety issues associated with electricity.

5. Traffic Incident Management - 3 hrs. (Afternoon)

In this class you will learn about scene size up, scene safety, proper truck placement, how to work with other agencies and what their objective are or will be.

6. EVOC training - 6 hrs.

This class will provide information and hands on practice of efficiently and safely operating emergency vehicles of various types and sizes.
