Purpose of Funds

Provide funding to organizations that offer shelter, advocacy, crisis counseling, and other victims' services to sexual assault, domestic violence, stalking, human trafficking, and other violent crime victims.

Eligible Applicants

- County governments
- Nonprofits having a 501(c)(3) status with the IRS
- Faith-based and neighborhood programs
- Native American tribal governments (Federally recognized)
- City or township governments
- Native American tribal organizations (other than Federally recognized tribal governments)

Match Requirements

VOCA

Pursuant to H.R. 1652 VOCA Fix to Sustain the Crime Victim Fund Act of 2021, waivers of any matching requirement, in its entirety will be applied in respect to a pandemic and ending on the date that is one year after the date of the end of such national emergency.

FVPSA

20% of the Total Project Budget

STOP (VAWA)

25% of Total Project Budget required to grants made to:

- Law Enforcement
- Prosecution
- Courts
