Subject: Requirement to Post Voter Registration Notice

In compliance with the National Voter Registration Act (NVRA) all offices where driver licensing and ID services are available (including county and city issue sites) must have a sign posted notifying the public voter registration services are available.

REMINDER: Anyone wishing to vote, whether they are applying for a driver's license/ID or not, can register to vote at any driver exam station or county/city issue site. An applicant must NOT be turned away or referred to any other office if they request to register to vote. Failure to allow someone to register to vote on the driver's license application form is a violation of the NVRA.
