Purpose of Funds

Courts, local public agencies, or nonprofit private entities. Program activities must include scholarships for income-eligible families for services such as:

- Mediation (voluntary and mandatory);
- Counseling;
- Parenting education;
- Development of parenting plans; and
- Visitation enforcement (including monitoring, supervision, neutral drop-off, and pick-up).
