Class 1 - Live Fire Training

Maximum number of students: 24.

Participants must have successfully completed the South Dakota Certified Firefighter Course and be proficient in the use of SCBA; Must be at least 18 years of age; Clean shaven; and provide their own NFPA compliant PPE and SCBA. Students are also encouraged to bring a spare air cylinder for their SCBA.

Instructors – Aberdeen Fire & Rescue – 6 Hour class

(As a courtesy we would ask that no more than 4 people per department sign up to take this class.)

Class 2 – Basic SCBA Training – including a smoke house drill in the afternoon.

Participants must be at least 18 years of age and provide their own NFPA compliant PPC and SCBA.

Class 3 -(Morning only) – Service Calls- How to handle CO & other routine service calls requiring a fire department response.
