Fire Inspector I

The Fire Inspector I Course is designed to provide a comprehensive program of instruction for fire inspectors and those desiring knowledge of fire inspection practices and procedures.

The requirements for Fire Inspector I are based on NFPA 1031-2009.

The Fire Inspector Course is referenced to the International Fire Code and NFPA 1.

The delivery format is a five-day course consisting of 40 hours of classroom instruction and practical skills. Students receive classroom lectures regarding the inspector's role, life safety, general fire safety, protection systems and hazardous materials for the inspector. In addition, students complete a series of practical skills involving inspections of sprinkler, alarm and hood systems, means of egress, identifying hazards, and fire department access.

For consistency and the convenience of the students, the program will coincide with the IFSTA manual, Fire Inspector Code Enforcement, Seventh Edition.

Topics include:

- Inspector authority and responsibilities
- Construction and occupancy classifications
- Inspection procedures
- Fire spread and growth factors
- Fire hazard recognition
- Fire detection systems
- Fire suppression systems
- Hazardous materials and special hazards
- Means of egress and occupancy loads

Registration – Due no later than December 19, 2014

Pre-registration is required and must be submitted and approved prior to the start of the course requested. This course is open to interested individuals who have met all prerequisites.

Fire Inspector Certification Exam

The written exam for this level consists of 100 multiple-choice questions referenced to the NFPA 1031 standard and IFSTA's Fire Inspection and Code Enforcement, Seventh Edition. Preparation for the exam should also include a review of Fire Behavior, Building Construction, and Hazardous Materials Awareness curriculum. Students have two hours to complete the written exam. The practical skills will be completed during the Fire Inspector Course.

South Dakota course completion certificates will be issued upon completion of the practical skills and a minimum score of 70% on the written exam.
