

South Dakota 911 Coordination Board  
Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt, Amend and Repeal Rules

A public hearing will be held in the Plains Room of the Clubhouse Hotel and Suites/ Redrossa Italian Grille, 808 West Sioux Avenue Pierre, South Dakota, on October 30th, at 10:00 a.m., to consider the adoption, amendment or repeal of proposed rules numbered:

§§ 50:02:04:10.01, 50:02:04:10.02 and 50:02:04:11 (proposed rules)  
§§ 50:02:04:03 and 50:02:04:07 (proposed amendments); and  
§ 50:02:02:04 (proposed repeal)

The effect of the rules will be to repeal surcharges procedures which are outdated under current law; to make the State 911 Board the authority on accepting emergency medical dispatch programs, rather than Law Enforcement Training; to specify that all annual fiscal reports must be submitted to the State 911 Board by March 31<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year; to address when 911 surcharge funds may or may not be used for communication equipment and physical addressing costs; and setting forth the procedure for determining public answering points' compliance with rules to receive 911 funds as set forth in 34-45-8.5

The reason for adopting, amending and repealing the proposed rules is to bring the rules into compliance with recently enacted legislation, to establish procedure and provide instruction on compliance with rules and applicable statutes.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Public Safety, 118 West Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Material sent by mail must reach the Department of Public Safety by October 29, 2012, to be considered.

After the hearing, the board will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The board may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Please notify the Department of Public Safety at least 48 hours before the public hearing if you have special needs for which special arrangements must be made.
